Subject: Show Cause Notice under Section 14(1)(e) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 –  
Regarding.

WHEREAS, it has been observed from the scrutiny of Form FC-4 filed by your association that there has been zero rupee utilisation of foreign contribution for project activities aligned with your stated aims and objectives and non-receipt of Foreign contribution for the following three consecutive financial years: FY [2021-2022], FY [2022-2023] and FY [2023-2024].

2. AND WHEREAS This non-utilisation raises concerns about whether your association has undertaken any reasonable activity in its chosen field for the benefit of society during the said period. As per Section 14(1)(e) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010, the Central Government may cancel the certificate of FCRA registration if the holder “has not been engaged in any reasonable activity in its chosen field for the benefit of the society for two consecutive years or has become defunct.”

3. AND WHEREAS, you are hereby called upon to show cause within 21 days from the date of issue of this notice as to why your association’s FCRA registration should not be cancelled under the said provision.

4. AND WHEREAS, you are directed to submit an explanation along with supporting documents, if any, through FCRA Portal, to justify the non-utilisation of foreign contribution during the above-mentioned period. Failure to submit a reply within the stipulated time will result in further action being taken ex parte, without any further reference to your association.
